CAMPING REQUIREMENTS

Cooking/Kitchen Requirements

- No flesh foods should be prepared while at Mountain View Summer Camp (MVSC)
- Bring your own Bucket(s) ~ Each camp site needs to have at least 1 bucket to carry water from the faucet to their campsite
- Bring your own Food Strainer ~ Each camp site needs to have a food strainer
 - Left over food needs to be strained



- Liquid (gray water) is strained into a bucket, pot or container and disposed of into the toilet (not onto the ground ~ this could attract unwanted visitors from the forest/woods)
- Solid food waste is to be disposed of into the GARBAGE CAN (not the toilet)

Bathroom Requirements

- Maximum of 2 people at a time (this includes anyone who may be in the shower)
- If scheduled, families (of more than 2) may go into the washroom together



- Each person (family group) is required to disinfect area's they are going to touch prior to using the facilities (toilet, sink, paper towel dispenser etc.) **"Family Group would be those who reside in the same household**
- Each person (family group) is required to disinfect anything they have touched before leaving the bathroom facility (toilet, sink, paper towel dispenser etc.)
- The next person (family group) is requested to do the same (as points above)
- Bring your own hand sanitizer/disinfectant, cleaning supplies

Laundry

Laundry facilities are NOT available during COVID19.



When you Leave

- Clean your camping area so it looks as it did before you came (or better)
- Clean any other area you (or your group) may have been during your stay. Pick up any garbage lying around.
