

Dear Parents and Campers,

Registration begins at 4:30 – 5:30 pm on the Sunday that your camp starts. Pick up is on the following Sunday between 8:00 – 9:00 am. We accept Visa, MasterCard, Money Orders or Cash at registration (*sorry no personal cheques*). - ** **Do NOT bring:** Phones, Electronics, Jewelry, Fireworks, Knives (Weapons), Alcohol, Cigarettes, drugs etc.

MEDICATIONS

- ALL medications must be in their original prescription bottles or containers.
- Vitamins and Supplements must be in their original bottles or containers.
- Any medications or tablets received in baggies will not be accepted.
- ALL medications must be given to the Camp Nurse at registration.
- Medications in bottles or containers will be returned.

REMINDER: Health Card

If you have not provided a Provincial Health/Care Card number, or other Health Insurance (outside of Canada) information, we will require that information at registration. The date of the last Tetanus shot is also required. Call us prior to registration at 778.769.5890 (Monday – Thursday).

Note: A Tetanus Shot is required except for medical or religious reasons. A letter of explanation will be needed at registration.

- *The Provincial Health Card # if provided on the day your camp begins may NOT appear on your account for future camps.*

Camp Hope is located 160 km east of Vancouver, BC on Hwy 7 approximately 11 km west of the town of Hope (61855 Lougheed Hwy, Hope BC)

From Vancouver: Follow signs to Hwy 1 East to Hope. After you pass through Chilliwack, take Exit 135 to Bridal Falls/Harrison Hot Springs. Exit to the right off Hwy 1 and another quick right. Follow Hwy 9 for about 8 km to Hwy 7. Follow Hwy 7 for about 26 km past Agassiz following signs to Hope. About 8 km before Hope is a red and white overhead pipeline. 1.5 km before the pipeline, on the left-hand side, is Mountain View Summer Camp (Camp Hope) entry. Camp is about .8 km in from Hwy 7.

Traveling West on Trans Canada Hwy 1: Exit right onto Hwy 7 at exit marked Harrison/Agassiz, just before entering Hope. Six and one half km west on Hwy 7 is a red and white overhead pipeline. One km past the pipeline take the first entry on the right marked "Camp Hope".

Traveling from Hwy 5 (Coquihalla) or Hwy 3: Take exit 170. At the stop sign turn left onto the Old Hope-Princeton Hwy. Proceed for 2 blocks to the traffic light. Turn right onto Hwy 1. Shortly after crossing the Fraser River Bridge take the exit to Hwy 7 West (to Agassiz). Proceed 8 km west. (which will be 1.5 km past the red and white overhead pipeline). Sign to Camp Hope is approximately 1 km beyond the pipeline on the right hand side.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON THE OTHER SIDE

Thank you for your application to Mountain View Summer Camp!! In addition to the information and instructions on the other side of this letter, here are a few more details you need you to be aware of:

- ✓ Registering and early payment help keep our costs down and we are pleased to pass on some savings to you when the following deadlines are met: \$150 Discount – March 31, 2022; \$100 Discount – May 31, 2022. After May 31, the full price is applicable at \$556.50 (includes registration fee and gst).
- ✓ Mountain View Summer Camp is not online for payments. Please call our office at 778.769.5890 to make your Visa or Master Card Payment only. We cannot process Debit/Visa's over the phone. Cash and debit payments are accepted in office: 1626 McCallum Road, Abbotsford, BC. Office hours: Monday – Thursday 9:00 am – 5:00 pm.
- ✓ On the day your camp begins, all accounts must be paid in full (note: discount(s) may be removed on balances not paid by coupon deadlines). We accept: Cash, Visa or Master Card at registration – CC payments will be processed as soon as possible the following week as there is no Credit Card machine at Camp.
- ✓ There is a \$50.00 late payment fee on accounts not paid in full on registration day. If your church is paying the camp fee, they can send a cheque to Mountain View Summer Camp. (A cheque from your church is accepted)
- ✓ Dietary Disclaimer: MVSC provides a healthy balanced menu. Wheat free, gluten free and dairy free diets are *NOT* provided. The kitchen does not guarantee a peanut free environment. Please contact the camp office at 1.604.869.5386 from June 15 – August 10 only or email sgibbons@bcadventist.ca at least one week prior to your camp start date if you have any questions or concerns regarding the menu.
- ✓ You can send your child a care package, please see instructions below. Please be sure it arrives no later than Thursday of their camp week, your child's name is written clearly on the outside of the package. Or leave package(s) with the staff at registration, with instructions on what day it is to be given to your child.
- ✓ TETANUS Shots: We must know when the last Tetanus Shot was given. Shots prior to 2012 need to be updated. If you are exempt for medical reasons please provide a letter from your doctor, or a letter from a parent for religious reasons.
